Traci Taylor Memorial Scholarship (Essay Required)

Traci Taylor raised two wonderful young men who attended schools in the Clovis Unified School District. Traci worked in the medical field for many years before dedicating her time to being a full-time mother. Traci was an encouragement to those who met her and was characterized by a smile on her face and an interest in those around her. In 2012, Traci's battle with cancer came to an end. This memorial scholarship is established in honor of Traci Taylor with the hope that it may assist the recipient as they pursue their academic goals beyond the Clovis Unified School District.

Anthony Aric Arroyo Memorial Scholarship (For BHS Swim/Water Polo and St. Baldrick's Club members)

He is well remembered as a member of the Buchanan High School Choir and for his humor, friendship, perseverance, and uniqueness. Anthony fought a good fight with cancer and FA and will always be remembered for his courage and strength. He enjoyed karate, playing video games, music and hanging out with his dog Buster. He was involved with Central California Blood Center speaking in front of hundreds of people to advocate the importance of giving blood and being on the bone marrow registry. Anthony also traveled to Washington D.C. to speak in front of legislators to advocate for bone marrow registry funding. In spite of his medical issues, Anthony was always eager to help others.
