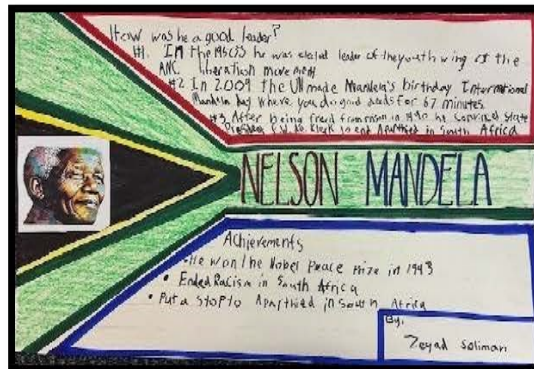
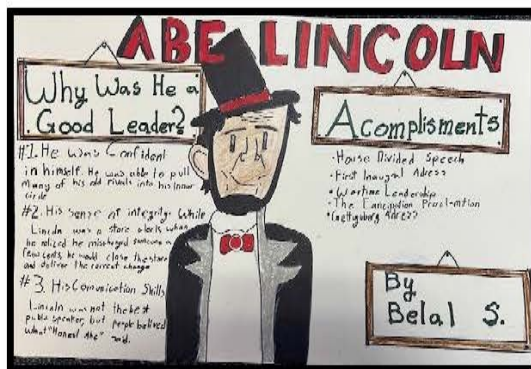
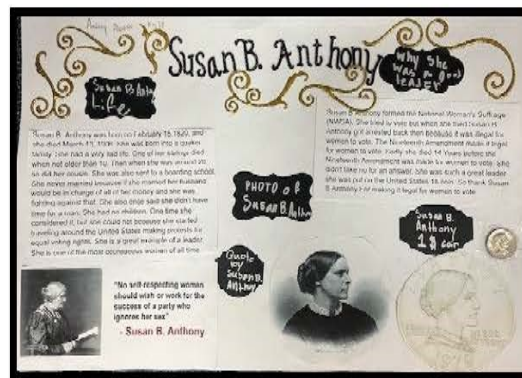
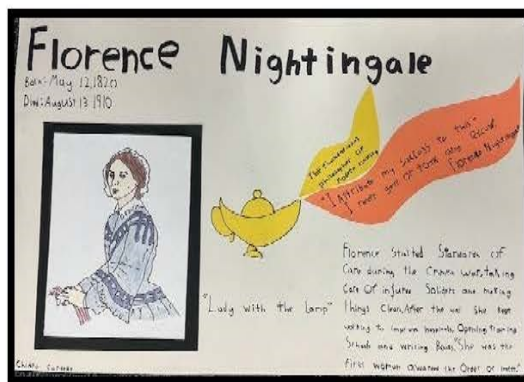


3rd Qtr. Poster and Essay Contest: Leadership

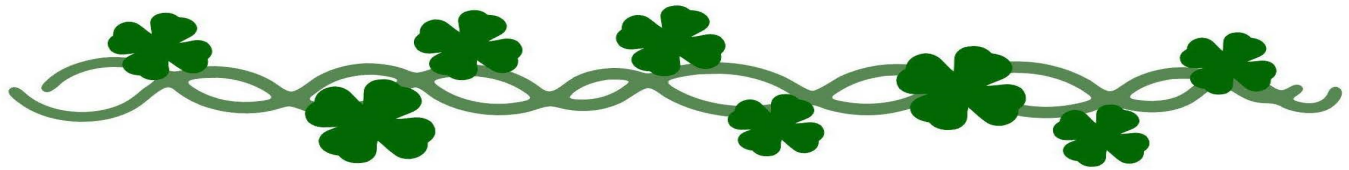
