How is "Character" Determined?

Teachers or Sponsors complete confidential evaluations of student character. (Link will be provided for teacher recommendation.)

Evaluations are based on classroom contact, extra-curricular activity participation, social media persona, and personal observation.

Attendance

Discipline records. This includes violations with plagiarism and cheating.

Leadership

Leadership includes being elected or selected to work in a LEADERSHIP role.
