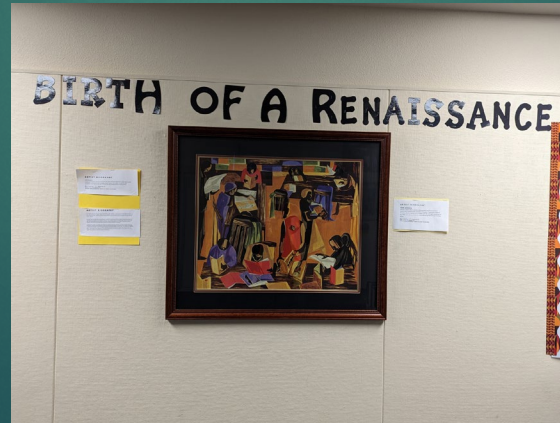
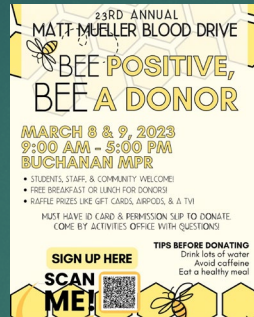

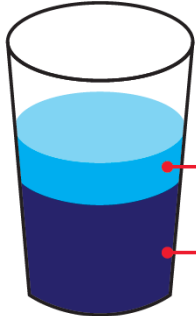

### Concentration Grant

Additional funds given to any school district whose percentage of qualifying students (English learner, low-income, and foster youth) exceeds 55%

### Supplemental Grant

Based on the district's number of unduplicated English learner, low-income, and foster youth students

### Base Grant

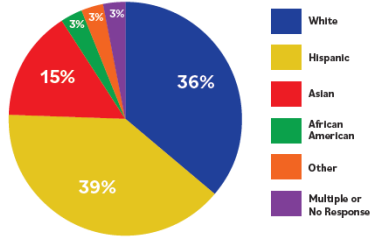
An equal amount provided to every district based on the average daily attendance rate and intended to fund all general operating expenses.

### Student Ethnicity



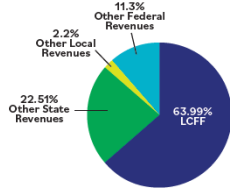
### 2022-2023 General Fund Revenue



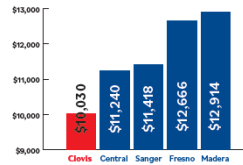
