The first step toward NHS membership is earning a weighted 3.7 (or higher) G.P.A., and participation in Honors, and Advanced Placement courses, and AP Exams.

Character

Character is who you are when no one is watching...

(It's already established!)

How is "Character" Determined?

Teachers or Sponsors complete confidential evaluations of student character.

Evaluations are based on classroom contact, extra-curricular activity participation, social media persona, and personal observation.

Attendance

Discipline records. This includes violations with plagiarism and cheating.

Leadership

Leadership includes being elected or selected to work in a LEADERSHIP role.
