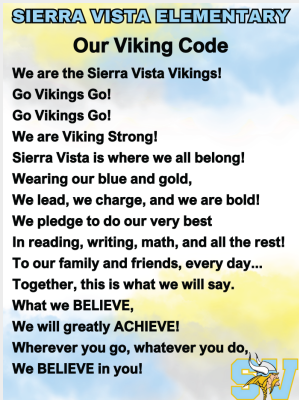


# Sierra Vista Elementary CAMPUS HIGHLIGHTS
