#### **IMPORTANT NEWS**

#### Breakfast at SV:

- Breakfast time is 7:15 AM to 7:35 AM. We will not serve breakfast after 7:35 AM so students can get to their lines and in class on time.
- Parents and family members (including siblings not in school)
   CANNOT be in the serving food area. Only SV students are allowed to enter and receive breakfast
- Due to school meals program regulations, food allergies, and California food safety... there is absolutely no sharing breakfast or lunch items with others and student's families/siblings. If this becomes an issue, especially at breakfast time, we will no longer allow parents and families to sit in the MPR with our students.

#### Parking and Traffic Safety:

- No parking on the handicap lots without a handicap placard. No parking on the handicap loading zone
- The Parent pick up lines at both Barstow and Pollasky parking lots are busy & can be unsafe.
   Drive in slowly, drop off or pick up students, and drive through so other vehicles can come through safely.
- There is ABSOLUTELY no jaywalking from the parking lots to the other side of the street due to busy traffic.
- Do not block traffic and buses by parking alongside the streets where this can cause safety issues. We have staff on supervision at all pick up locations.
