Love makes someone happy! 	BLACK HISTORY HERITAGE MONTH “GEORGE WASHINGTON CARVER” George Washington Carver was a scientist and an inventor who nurtured the land and people’s minds. As an inventor, he found hundreds of ways to use peanuts. He was imaginative! He also experimented legumes to make so many man-made products such as flour, soups, dyes, plastics, lotions, and gasoline. Carver was born an enslaved person in the 1860s in the state, Missouri. While being raised by a plantation owner, George worked on the family farm and in their garden. That was where George became inquisitive about plants, soil, and fertilizers. People called him the plant doctor! Later in 1894, he became the first Black person to graduate from Iowa State College.
