Facility Bonds at Our School

The 2024 Measure A facility bond would fund the following projects at Fancher Creek Elementary High School:

- MPR Modernization
- Library Shelving/Storage
- Roof Replacement
- Safety Enhancements
- AV Technology Improvements
- LED Lighting Upgrades

Since 2012, Fancher Creek Elementary School has received the following projects funded by two Measure A facility bonds:

- Expanded library space for storage and instructional area
- Replaced roofing
- Repaired landscape
- Completed Americans with Disabilities Act updates kindergarten wing
- Installed additional student drop-off area
- Repaired door hardware, casework and wall finishes
- Upgraded classroom audio-visual systems
- Added security cameras
- Improved exterior lighting
- Upgraded technology network and wireless system
- Improved play-court surfaces and turf conditions
- Completed Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) required upgrades



Every school facility in Clovis Unified has benefited from bond projects not once or twice, but many times over. Across the District, bond funds have been used for:



Fixing leaking roofs, electrical wiring, fire safety doors and smoke alarms



Repairing and upgrading deteriorating science, engineering and math classrooms to provide modern learning spaces at all of our schools



Building new schools and adding space at existing schools to reduce overcrowding



Building new performing arts and athletic spaces and upgrading others



Making needed updates to facilities to provide safe, clean drinking water



Improving school safety and security by updating communication systems and security systems



Maintaining equitable facilities at schools of all ages through modernization and maintenance projects
