Scholarship amounts range from \$7000 to \$22,000. **ELIGIBILITY:** 2019 graduates with 2.0 or higher, student whose family makes \$55,000 or less annually. - Nov 15 **ELKS MOST VALUABLE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP** They are looking for students that are **very involved in school and community activities**. The top 25 male and female candidates in the state are forwarded on to the National judging committee and can be awarded as much as \$50,000 to help pay for their college education. The 20 top finalists will participate in an all-expenses paid **Leadership Weekend** in Chicago during which they’ll interview with the national judges.
