Mrs. Kismet thanked parents for joining the meeting and provided an overview for our discussion and agenda items. The LCAP parent presentation was shared in excerpts providing parents an overview of the LCAP, Introduction by Dr. O'Brien, and an overview of the funding. Mrs. Kismet paused the presentation to invite questions. Mrs. Kismet provided an overview of the LCAP funds and how they have impacted and benefitted our school site, providing the following examples and information on: SOAR, CSI, Transition Support, push in support in grades 1-4, after/before school intervention grades 1-4, as well as PBIS and the Positivity Project. Mrs. Kismet shared the Thought Exchange QR coded and invited parents to share feedback that would go directly to the district office. Additionally, parents were informed a copy of the presentation would be sent to them along with the QR code for the thought exchange.

### CARES funding

Mrs. Kismet provided an overview of the CARES funding and how it has supported MC. She referenced the COVID assistant which has helped us with testing students and supporting the health office and cares room, 1 additional campus monitor each day (10 hours per week), as well as the recent hiring of a temp contract teacher. Mrs. Kismet shared that these three additional staffing resources have made a significant impact on our campus.

Mrs. Kismet provided an overview of the day with students who opted to not wear a mask and how the school responded. She referenced that it is still a Ca. Mandate that students are required to wear masks and by law that we must implement it. and that we continue to care for their spirit. She highlighted that she wanted students and families to know that together we will continue to work

A question was asked about protestors and signs, it was communicated by a parent that appeared to be misinformation that masks were lifted. Mrs. Kismet clarified that if there would be change that she has always communicated via email. An additional question was asked about the status of the vaccination requirement. Mrs. Kismet responded that we have not received any information yet about the vaccination requirement.
