



Mac and Kids/IDAC MINUTES April 19th, 2022

African American Student Club Presentation

1. Miss Zevenbergen opened up the meeting by welcoming everyone, reviewing MAC N Kids expectations, reviewing the Google classroom assignment, and requirements for earning a Block H point. She introduced the guest speakers from the Clovis West African American Club and then parents and students broke out into different sessions. Parents met with Mrs. Kismet for the parent IDAC meeting while students attended Mac N Kids.
2. Parent Break-Out Room Meeting, Mrs. Kismet gave a status of the school highlighting a few upcoming events. She referenced that staff were excited that we could return to normal with our school events and explained to parents that these last 2 months of school will look the same as they did pre-COVID. She did remind parents that masks are optional for those who may be uncomfortable in large group settings (awards, drama, etc.) Mrs. Kismet also mentioned that about 1 in 4 students is still continuing to wear a mask by choice and that it was the school's goal to ensure that all students feel safe and comfortable.
3. Mrs. Kismet highlighted the upcoming Carnival and encouraged parents to get involved. She highlighted the SHRL leadership meetings that she holds. The purpose of SHRL's and their recent campaign idea, "say a good word" that they would be launching.
4. Mrs. Kismet reviewed the Student SART surveys and Parent SART surveys. Within her review she shared 2 documents for each survey. The first document summarized the top 3 commendations as: 1-staff 2-environment/culture and 3-communication. The second document shared was a summary of any patterns with suggestions for improvements, the following three areas were noted as recommendations for improvement with no one area having more than 5 parent comments / suggestions for improving; 1- Communication, 2-Diversity, 3-COVID. Mrs. Kismet explained the process for identifying commonalities in comments on the survey. In addition, she added that there wasn't as much of a common thread for the areas of improvement with the highest number of comments for any improvement area being 5 comments however the school is required to identify three areas for improvement. The same two documents were shared as summary to the student surveys. The top 3 student commendations were 1-staff, 2-Sports, 3 Recess/lunch. The top 3 student areas for growth were 1-food, 2-recess, and 3-cleanliness. Sample comments were shared for all document.
5. Mrs. Kismet opened the final portion of the meeting up for any questions or input. There was no specific input in this area. All parents were thanked for their attendance throughout the year.
