Why Bell Schedule Change?

**SB328
In Effect
2022-23**

A new law that requires California's intermediate and high schools to revise start times by the start of the 2022-23 school year.

- Intermediate Schools no earlier than 8:00 a.m.,
- High Schools no earlier than 8:30 a.m.
- Shared Operations (transportation, food service, etc.) Require Changes at Most, if Not All, Sites



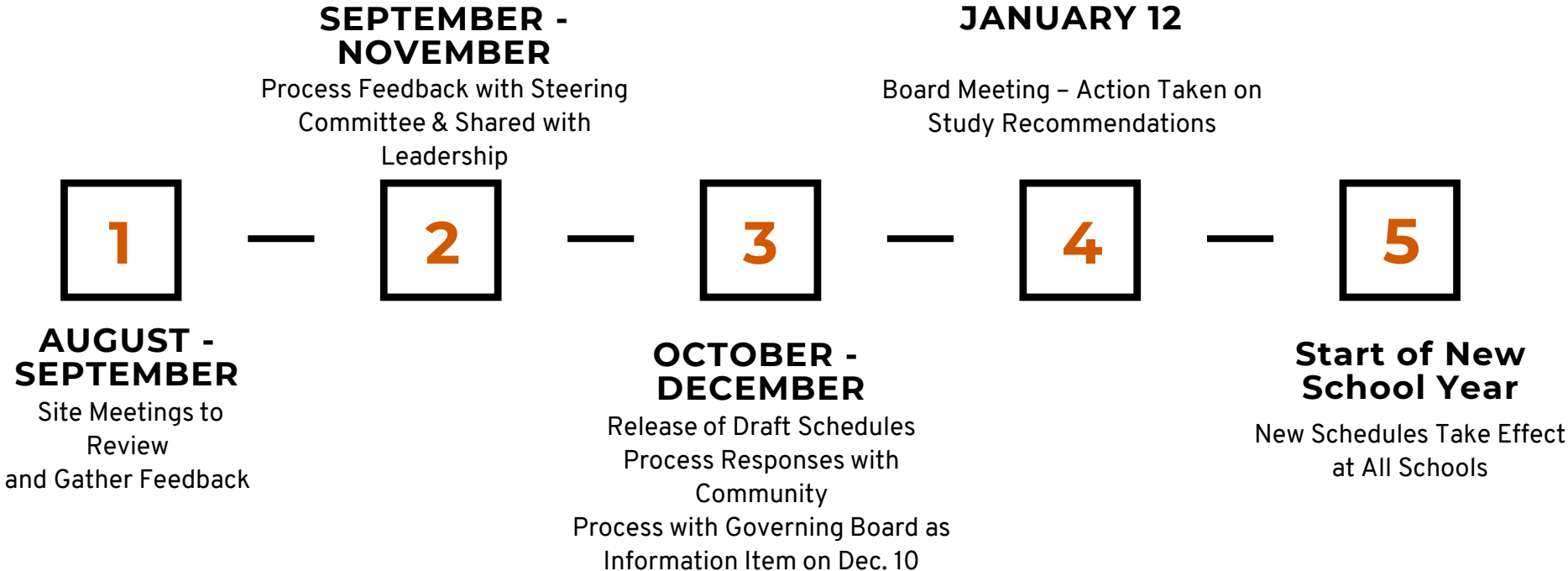
Why Elementary Changes...

If SB328 is For Grades 7-12?

While SB328 specifically addresses grades 7-8, and 9-12, Clovis Unified's transportation, food service, custodial and other support services serve grades K-12.

- Elementary bus schedules for both traditional and Special Education routes and co-curricular/activities
- Meal Preparation
- Custodial and Maintenance Schedules

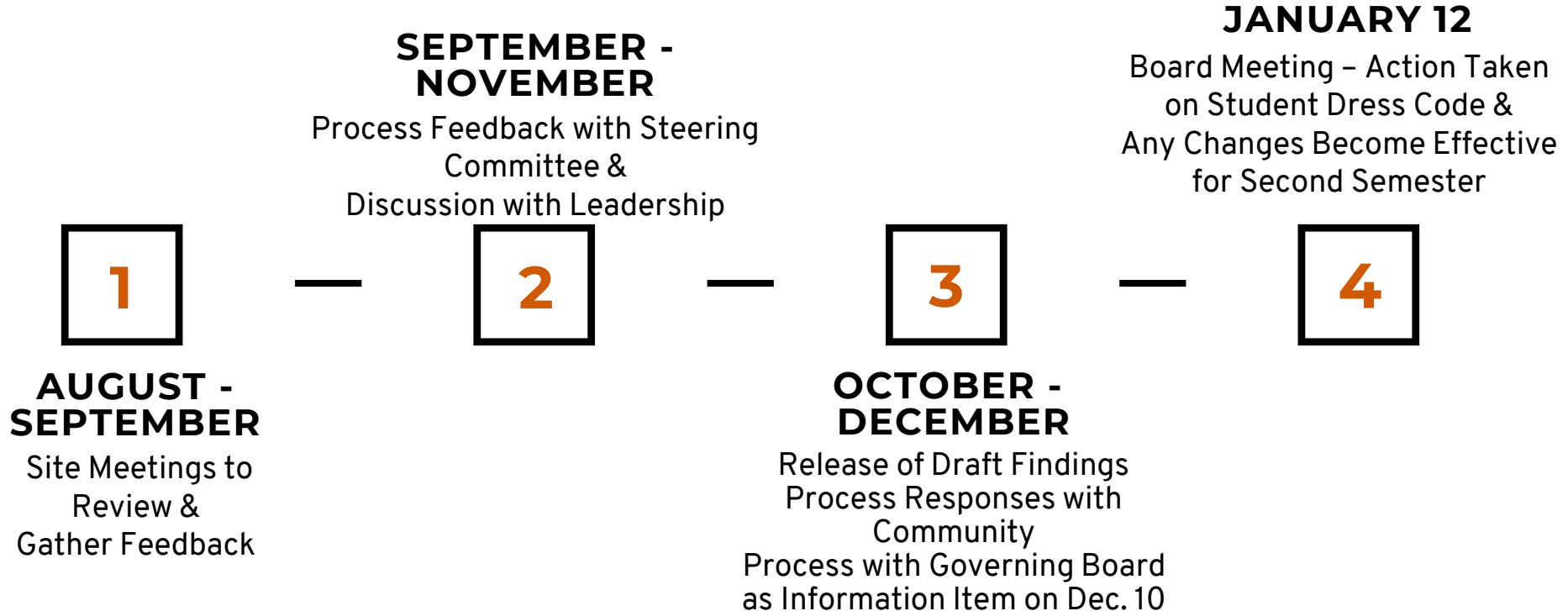

(Ed Code 35183, Section 302 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations)

- Consistently Enforced
- Addresses Potential Safety Threats to Students
