Classrooms: Summer School will be in-person only with no online portion. Summer School is designed for students who are below grade level and need additional instruction to prepare for the 2023-2024 school year. For more information about your child's Summer School recommendation please contact their current teacher or your school's GIS.

Curriculum: Teachers will be focusing on English Language Arts (Reading, Writing, Language) and Math.

Placement: Teachers will email parents on Wednesday, June 14th with placement information and directions for the first week of summer school.

Materials: Students do not need to bring backpacks to school. Paper, folders, pencils, etc. will be provided. There is no homework, students are expected to complete work assigned during class time. There will be no need for a computer at home.

Breakfast & Lunch: Breakfast and lunch will be provided to ALL students free of charge as part of summer school.

Dress Code: The CUSD Dress Code is in effect for Summer School.

Arrival: Students may be on campus after 7:30 am and will report to Blacktop or Cafeteria.

Absences: Parents please call in if your child is ill to 559-327-7576. Students will be dropped if absences become excessive. Summer School does not offer Independent Studies or makeup work.

Communication: The Summer School newsletter will be sent via email weekly with reminders, news, and the weekly calendar.

Transportation Students from Bud Rank, Copper Hills, Fugman, and Riverview will be eligible for CUSD bus transportation from their home school. A bus schedule will be sent to parents at a later date. Please mark yes on the application if interested.
