Dress Code enforced at Walk-Thru Registration

Off Campus Pass procedure

For your convenience and to serve you and your student better, we are requesting you telephone ahead to authorize off-campus passes for doctor, dental and personal business appointments whenever possible. This will minimize the number of interruptions to the classroom and avoid delays due to circumstance out of our control, such as: student is in P.E. class, testing, etc.

You may call our 24-hour attendance number at 327-2251. Please leave your student's name, ID#, the reason for leaving and time of release so we can have the off-campus ready for your student to pick up prior to going to the class he/she needs to leave. **Off Campus Passes are not delivered and reminders are not given.**

IMPORTANT! Off-campus passes must be obtained before leaving campus; failure to obtain an off-campus pass prior to leaving campus may result in disciplinary action.

Due to Clovis Unified School District's closed campus policy all 9th, 10th and 11th grade students must be picked up and signed out in the attendance office by their parent or guardian when the student is leaving within the ½ hour before lunch and during the scheduled lunch hour.

What to do if...

- **Your child is arriving late to school.**
- **Your child needs to leave school early.**

1. For your convenience and to serve you and your student better, we request you **call ahead for all passes.**

Late arrivals or students returning from appointments must check in at the attendance office before going to class to be cleared.

2. To avoid delays and minimize interruption to the classroom, **please remind your student to come to the attendance office to pick up his/her off-campus pass** before attending the class he/she needs to leave from. **Reminders are not given and passes are not delivered.**
3. Be aware of your student's class schedule* when making appointments. Expect delays when picking up from P.E. class or during testing if you have not called ahead or your student did not pick up his/her pass.
4. **Due to the Clovis Unified closed campus policy all 9th, 10th, 11th and senior students who do not have a senior off campus lunch card must be physically picked up and signed out by their parent/guardian from the attendance office during the hour of 11:30 am - 12:30 pm on a regular schedule or ½ hour before and during the lunch period for varied schedules. (No exceptions)**
5. **Off-Campus Passes** must be picked up from the Attendance Office before leaving campus; failure to obtain a pass will result in the student being referred to the Student Responsibility Center (SRC) and disciplinary action may be taken.

You may call our 24-hour attendance number at 327-2251 to request an off-campus pass or an admit slip for late arrival. Please leave your name, your student's name and ID number, the time and reason for leaving or the reason for late arrival.

Dear Parents,

Clovis West High School is in the process of electing members to the School Site Council (SSC) for the 2021-2022 school year. The SSC is required for schools receiving categorical funds such as Title I and Title III funds. These funds are used to supplement the regular school program. Clovis West High School receives the following categorical funds: Title III Immigrant, Title III English Learner, LCAP and LCAP Intervention.

The purpose of the of the SSC is to ensure the school is continually engaged in identifying and implementing curriculum and instructional practices resulting in strengthening the core academic program and ensuring pupils have access and success in school. This core program should embody the District's curriculum, which itself should reflect the state frameworks and curriculum standards. The SSC is charged with the task to develop and approve the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA); which is a comprehensive plan designed to improve the effectiveness of the school program. The school's improvement effort should also be coordinated with the District's effort to upgrade its curriculum offerings and quality of instruction in order that both the school, through the SSC, and the Governing Board, through the District Office, become part of a single improvement effort. The council shall carry out all other duties and responsibilities assigned to it in the Education Code of the State of California.

Clovis West High School in Clovis Unified School District (CUSD) has designated our School Site Council (SSC) established pursuant to California Education Code (EC) Section 52852 to function as the School Advisory Committee (SAC). One member of the SAC designates one member from the school SSC to serve as a voting member on the District Advisory Committee (DAC). SAC serves an advisory committee for the purpose of advising schools regarding their specific categorical programs and the role of developing the LCAP in the creation of a plan that will make a meaningful difference in the lives of our students. The District Advisory Committee (DAC) will engage in meaningful consultation, under the guidelines provided by Administrative Procedure 9062, on any program changes that have not originated from the DAC.

In order to accomplish this task, the SSC meets on a regular basis to assess student needs, develop and approve the plan including categorical budgets, and monitor its implementation. At Clovis West High School the SSC meets on a quarterly basis in the Administrative Conference Room

Members of the SSC include the principal, classroom teachers, other staff members, parents, and at the secondary level, students. Members of the SSC are elected by their peers; therefore parents are elected by parents. Two parents need to be elected this year for the 2021-2022 SSC. A member serves for two years. If you are interested in being a member of the SSC, please fill out the nomination form below and return it to school with your child no later than August 30, 2019. After all nominations are in, a ballot will be sent home to all parents. The two parents with the highest number of votes will serve on the SSC.

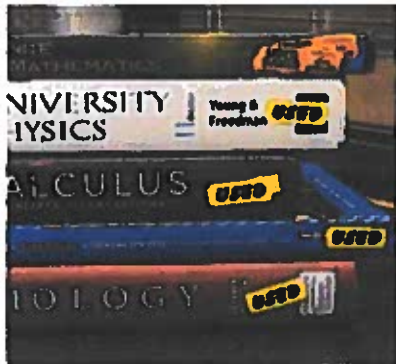
3. LOST/STOLEN TEXTBOOKS:

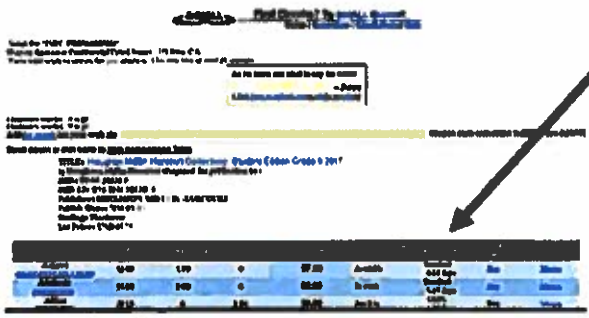
