Audition Lines- be prepared to read lines for one of the characters in groups of 5.

FAIRY GODMOTHER: I just want to be sure the prince is mesmerized by Cinderella when she enters the ball wearing this gown.

LORD DUNN: I think you've succeeded. Tell me, what's your secret?

FAIRY GODMOTHER: (Holds up her wand and smiles.) Can't go wrong with a little bit of magic!

CHUCK: Seriously? She gets a magic wand?!

FAIRY GODMOTHER: We're all just working with what we've got.

CHUCK: Easy for you to say! All I've got are some sharp teeth and a useless tail!

LORD DUNN: (To FAIRY GODMOTHER.) Got any more tricks up your sleeve that you'd like to show me?

FAIRY GODMOTHER: I'd rather save them for the runway.

LORD DUNN: Good thinking. Speaking of the runway... (Pulls out a pocket watch, looks at it, and calls out.) Time's up, designers! To the runway! Let's get it Dunn!

(CHUCK sighs as MODELS EXIT. LORD DUNN leads CHUCK and FAIRY GODMOTHER over to the JUDGES.) Cinderella, Stepmother, thank you for judging this episode of Runway Magic. Tonight our contestants had the challenge of creating Cinderella's gown for the prince's ball without the use of traditional sewing tools.

CINDERELLA: How creative!

STEPMOTHER: How ridiculous!

LORD DUNN: Chuck, you're up first.

CHUCK: Great. (To JUDGES.) I wanted to create a gown that would highlight Cinderella's simple beauty and elegance while emphasizing her appreciation for nature. (MUSIC CUE: UPBEAT RUNWAY MUSIC. SPOTLIGHT ON as MODEL ONE ENTERS UPSTAGE. She struts DOWN the runway, pausing and posing in front of the JUDGES, then continues DOWN to the end of the runway, posing for the AUDIENCE. MUSIC OUT. MODEL ONE struts back UPSTAGE and EXITS as JUDGES comment. SPOTLIGHT OFF.)

CINDERELLA: I think it's simply charming.

STEPMOTHER: You would say something like that. You've always had a soft spot for woodland creatures.

CINDERELLA: What's not to love, Stepmother? They're always so kind and helpful!

STEPMOTHER: Maybe to you, but not so much for the rest of us. I asked your mice friends to run and grab some groceries for me just once, but did they listen? Of course not!

CINDERELLA: Why don't we get back to the gown? I think Chuck added some nice details along the neckline.
