Trip Costs



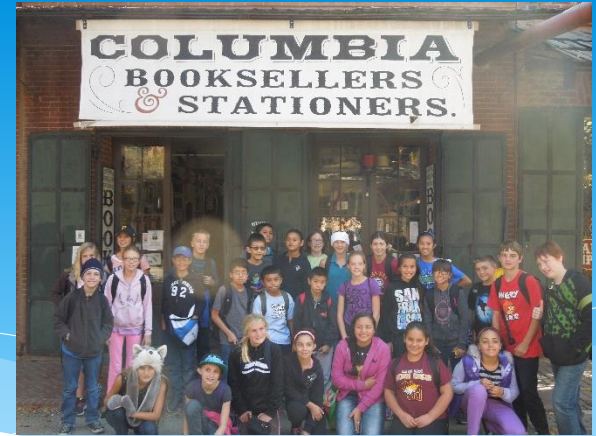
- * Charge for students to attend is \$240.00
- * This cost includes all meals (except day 1 lunch), transportation fees, lodging, and activities.
- * Students will be able to fundraise for their tuition costs through our Jog-a-thon fundraiser. 6th grade students will receive 50% credit of their total jogathon collection.
- * Spending money is optional – We recommend no more than \$25.00
- * Chaperones are asked to pay the same price as the students.

Packing



- * 3 day/2-night trip –please plan accordingly
- * Average temps in Sonora for mid October are in the 60’s with temps dropping as low as the high 40’s. Make sure your child has appropriate clothing.
- * Good shoes that can get dirty and stay sturdy.
- * All students must remain in dress code.
- * Bring all toiletries etc... nothing is available at camp. A list is provided in the packet.
- * NO ELECTRONICS!!!!
- * Disposable type cameras are best. However, if you allow your child to bring a digital camera, it is at your risk. Lost or stolen cameras will not be replaced.

Before Trip



- * All fees/permission slips are due by Friday, September 30th.
- * Food allergy, medicine forms and medicine are due to the nurse by Friday, September 23rd.
- * We cannot, by law, give any child, any medicine without a doctors note. This includes any over the counter medicines!
- * Sick children may NOT attend the trip.
- * The bus **MUST** leave at 7:00a.m. Please make sure your child is on time. Students should report to school at 6:45 a.m.

During Trip



- * Please read over rules and conduct policies carefully with your child.
- * Your child will be at a school function on CUSD property. Violation of a rule there is the same as violating the rule at school.
- * Major violations may result in you having to pick up your child at the SOS.
- * If a child becomes ill with a temperature over 100 degrees or develops symptoms, we will ask that you pick up your child from camp. Please keep the directions handy that were provided tonight- just in case!

Chaperones



- * Official chaperone spaces are VERY limited. Parents will be randomly selected as official chaperones and will be notified by Mrs. Chance by next week. Prior to this overnight trip, chaperones will go through LiveScan fingerprinting clearance, a TB assessment, and they will agree to follow all safety protocols during this trip.
- * SOS will not allow any additional visitors on campus for this trip.
