## CODE OF ETHICS CONTRACT

Co-Curricular students are a select group of students who are held to a higher standard of rules and accountability. Please note the following standards and requirements that you are committing to:

- Attendance, participation, and support are expected at athletic and academic events.
- You must be encouraging and supportive of all REC students on campus, at all times.
- \*Respect and positive attitudes must be shown to <u>all</u> staff members, <u>all</u> fellow students, and <u>all</u> guests on campus and within the district <u>at all times</u>; this same respect must be shown to your parents/guardians.
- Promoting leadership, diversity, unity, and harmony are common goals and guidelines for all Leadership Team members.
- Abiding by and supporting all school rules, including the CUSD dress code, promotes a mindset of respect even if you do not agree with all the rules.
- Promoting and advocating positive school spirit, respect and decorum at all school events including dances, athletic events, etc. is expected
- Completing several hours in the student store (rotation basis)
- Dedicating personal time before school, after school and weekends to promote CEHS activities is expected.
- \*\*A 2.5 GPA must be maintained at all times; excellent attendance is mandatory!
- 10 hours or more of community service must be completed each semester.
- 2 hours of school service must be completed each week through Activities
- Violence, hatred, or harassment will not be tolerated from Leadership Students.
- Avoidance either directly or indirectly with all illegal and zero-tolerance issues such as alcohol use, drug use, cigarette use, etc. at **ALL TIMES, INCLUDING OFF CAMPUS.**
- Gossip and mean-spiritedness will not be tolerated; anything considered unethical will not be tolerated.
- Abusing co-curricular / leadership classroom privileges may result in removal from the leadership program.
- Avoidance of any or all referrals based on behavior and /or attendance problems.
- Any forgery of signatures of any staff member or community member that is signing off hours of school or community service will result in disciplinary action. Forgery/Cheating of any kind will NOT be tolerated.

## 10 "SURVIVAL TIPS" & CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

(Discipline vs. Development)

- 1. **Communication is Key:** leaders are in constant communication with their captains, officers, and advisor. If you are running late, you communicate. If you have to miss, you communicate. If you have an idea, you communicate.
- 2. **Lights On, Lights Off:** leaders are the first ones to arrive and the last ones to leave. Leaders never leave an event or activity until after we do our Presidential Break and photo. If you miss the break, then you left too soon!
- 3. **Dress Up Days & Spirit Fridays:** leaders are required to dress up each time we have a dress up day. Also, every Friday (ALL YEAR) leaders are expected to wear their school colors (Blue/Green/Silver, or Pack Pride shirts).
- 4. Promote Every Event like you are the Person in Charge: leaders are required to promote every single leadership activity and event.
- 5. **Reach or Exceed all Fundraising Goals:** leaders need to make sure they help raise money for the program. This means that whatever the goal is per fundraiser, leaders need to reach or exceed the requirement.
- 6. **Turn in Paperwork on Time:** leaders need to make sure they turn in all required paperwork before or on the date that it is due.
- 7. **Work Hard:** at no time should a leader display laziness. Leaders need to display a strong work ethic at all times.
- 8. **Serve over Self:** at the conclusion of an activity or event, leaders clean up first and socialize second.
- 9. **Spirit over Status:** at activities, events, or games; leaders are there to cheer and support! Put your phones away, "chill" with your friends later, it's time to be spirited!
- 10. **Be Productive in Class:** find something to do every day in class that adds value to our leadership program. This is not a "free" period, a time to do homework, or a place to just hang out.

Leaders that are able to survive these 10 things qualify themselves to be **DEVELOPED** into real leaders. These are the bare minimum expectations. If you struggle with these things, I will have to spend the time I have redirecting/disciplining you as opposed to developing you. I can't develop you as a leader if you can't first do these 10 things
