SENIOR ACTIVITIES


All senior activities are considered a privilege, including the graduation ceremony. Students must be in good standing by meeting all graduation requirements to participate.

STUDENT ID CARDS/DRESSCODE



Students must have their physical ID card to participate in senior activities, including graduation practices.

• Replacement ID Cards can be purchased in the Activities Office for \$10



- The CUSD hair/dress code policies will be in effect for ALL school activities • Failure to comply with the dress code policy will result in removal from one or more senior activities, including the Graduation ceremony. There is a special Graduation Dress Code that applies to the Graduation Ceremony, Parade of Graduates, and Baccalaureate. This is outlined in detail in

GRADUATION DRESS CODE

GRADUATION DRESS CODE

- Students must wear semi-formal or formal attire. This includes suit and tie, slacks with collared shirt and tie, dresses, dress pants or skirts with blouse, etc. NO DENIM and NO SHORTS are allowed.
- All dresses must have at least two-inch shoulder straps. Long dresses are permitted, but must be pinned so they do not fall below the hemline of the graduation gown. Undergarments are not allowed to be shown. No sheer straps or panels.
- Shoes that will NOT be permitted include, but are not limited to: athletic shoes, slides, Birkenstocks, Vans, flip-flop style sandals, crocks, Dr. Martens, combat boots, etc. We recommend low-heeled shoes or flats.
- All clothing must meet CUSD Dress Code regulations. In addition to the information above, students may not have facial piercings, distracting hair color, or distracting makeup, jewels, etc. In addition, facial hair should be nicely groomed.
- Caps will be worn flat on the head with the point aimed straight ahead (no caps for baccalaureate).
- The gown must be completely zipped during the entire event.
- Tassels will be worn on the right side of the cap. Bling tassels (if purchased from Grad Services) are allowed.

ADORNMENTS

- The only acceptable accessories to the standard school-issued cap and gown are the CSF Life Gold Cord, AVID Cord (silver), State Seal of Biliteracy Medallion, National Honor Society Medallion, and the Principal's Medallion. • Requests for any other accessory not listed above must be submitted to the Deputy Principal at least two weeks prior to the graduation ceremony. Anything received after May 16th will not be accepted. Please see the Deputy Principal's
- office for the appropriate request form.

SENIOR OBLIGATIONS

FINANCIAL / TEXTBOOK / CO-CURRICULAR OBLIGATIONS

Deadline for senior obligations is May 20th by 4:00pm



Only cash, money orders, or certified checks will be accepted after April 19th

SENIOR WHITE CARD DAY - MAY 20th



Last day of academic classes and a full school day. Seniors who fail to earn sufficient credit to graduate will be issued a white card and will not be allowed to participate in Senior Activities. • Grad Nite money will not be refunded

SENIOR CHECK-OUT - MAY 21st



Once all obligations have been met, seniors will turn in check-out forms in the East Gym. Once cleared, they will proceed to the West Gym to get their cap & gown




