

# Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP)

# Expanded Learning

“Expanded learning” means before school, after school, summer, or intersession learning programs that focus on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on, engaging learning experiences.

# ELOP Programming

**Core Instructional Day** (includes recess/lunch)  
+  
**Expanded Learning** (Before or After School or both)

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**9 hours**

On schooldays, must provide in-person before and/or after school expanded learning opportunities that when added to daily instructional minutes are **no less than 9 hours of combined** instructional time and expanded learning opportunities per instructional day.

# ELOP Programming

For **at least 30 non-school days**, during intersessional periods, **no less than 9 hours** of in-person expanded learning opportunities per day

This requirement aligns with the state fiscal year (Starts July 1st and ends June 30th)

*\*Piloting Summer ELOP (June 13-July28) for students enrolled in Summer School.*

- Early Dismissal @ 4pm
