	Which students are returning on Monday, November 30, 2020?	Transitional Kindergarten through 3 rd Grades
	Which students are returning on Monday, December 7, 2020?	4 th through 6 th Grades
	What days are AM Kids on Campus before January 19, 2021?	AM students will attend class in-person on Mondays and Thursdays and Zoom all other days.
	What are the AM times?	8:15-8:30am – Drop -Off 8:30-11:15am – Instruction 11:15-11:30am – Pick-Up
	What days are PM kids on Campus before January 19, 2021?	PM students will attend class in-person on Tuesdays and Fridays and Zoom all other days.
	What are the PM times?	12:15-12:30pm – Drop -Off 12:30-3:15pm – Instruction 3:15-3:30pm – Pick-Up
	How long will my student be on campus for in-person instruction?	Students are on campus for 2 hours and 45 minutes, but they must be available for learning from 8am-3:15pm.

Arriving On Campus		
	What should I bring with me to school?	Your backpack with essentials only and a personal, sealable water bottle.
	Bus Riders:	Students will be picked up at their assigned bus stop and MUST have their assigned bus pass and TK Student ID Card with them. They will be dropped off in the bus lane reserved only for buses on Armstrong Avenue.
	Parent Drop-Off and Pick-Up:	Students will be dropped off and picked up by parents in the drop-off zone on Olive Avenue ONLY. Students MUST have their TK Student ID Card

		with them and only students may exit the vehicle.
	Can parents/guardians/adults volunteer on campus?	At this time, only CUSD employees are allowed on campus.
	Can parents/guardians/adults walk children to the classroom?	Students will need to be dropped off at the drop-off zone on Olive Avenue and adults must remain in the vehicle. TK Staff will be sure all students report to their classrooms.
Keeping Students and Staff Healthy and Safe		
	When does cleaning take place of classrooms and bathrooms?	There is a regular rotation for cleaning the public use spaces on campus, including the restrooms. Teachers will disinfect student spaces every day after the students leave the classroom and our custodial team will sanitize every room at the end of each day.
	Are masks required? And what about face shields?	Masks that cover the mouth and nose are required to be worn by all children and adults at all times on campus. Face shields do not replace face masks but may be worn in addition to a face mask.
Meal Service		
	How will students receive their breakfast and lunch?	Meals will be handed to students as they are leaving campus. For the days that students are not on campus, families will need to utilize drive-thru meal service at Clovis East High School.
	Will water be available to students?	Unfortunately, for health and safety reason, drinking fountains are required to be turned off. Please be sure to send your student with a personal water bottle that is full in order to get through their time on campus.
Student Dismissal		
	Bus Riders:	Students will be dismissed to the buses and will load the bus by family in order of drop-off.
	Parent Pick-Up	Students will be dismissed to the blacktop to wait as a family for parent arrival. The family name will be called for students to report to the vehicle.
