Student Council Job Descriptions

President - 6th grade

- Presides over Student Council meetings
- Gives tasks to committees and individuals

Vice-President - 5th or 6th grade

- Acts in Behalf of the President when he/she is unavailable

- Helps the Comm. of Athletics with the ball basket daily, when school resumes in person

Secretary - 5th or 6th grade

- Keeps attendance and records of all meetings
- Makes a calendar of meetings and events
- Is responsible for thank you & birthday cards and notes

- Helps Comm. of Athletics with Game Day set up when school resumes in person

Treasurer - 5th or 6th grade

- Keeps records of all student expenditures and income
- Gives clear and simple reports at each meeting
- Counts all money brought in by the Student Council

- Helps Rally Comm. put up Game Day sign when school resumes in person

5th Grade Class President - 5th grade

- Attends and participates in all Student Council Meetings
- Asks for the ideas and opinions of their fellow classmates
- Will be required to attend some evening school activities when school resumes in person
- Put up the American flag each day, arrive to school by 7:45 am for this task when school resumes in person

4th Grade Class President - 4th grade

- Attends and participates in all Student Council meetings
- Asks for the ideas and opinions of their fellow classmates
- Will be required to attend some evening school activities when school resumes in person
- Put up the American flag each day, arrive to school by 7:45 am for this task when school resumes in person

School Mascot- 4th, 5th, or 6th grade

- Cheer on crowds during rallies and other school activities when school resumes in person
 - Prepare a weekly video submission by Wednesday morning for Friday announcements
 - Be prepared with the Patriot mascot outfit on activity days
 - Make sure you are comfortable being in an enclosed environment, the mascot's head covers your entire head

- Will help create and lead student games/competitions at school rallies once per month
- Will help promote school spirit at all school functions
