

Application for Student Council Elections STUDENT COUNCIL CAMPAIGN GUIDELINES

1. If a student has been removed or resigned from a student council office, a Fort Washington administrator must sign your application to allow you to run.
2. **NO** social media campaigning will be allowed.
3. You **MAY** have **ONE** campaign manager (may not be a candidate for any office). This is **NOT** a requirement. Managers **MAY NOT** be current Student Council members.
4. Students will create a campaign video lasting no longer than one minute. You may include appropriate music and signs if you choose. Please make sure you follow CUSD's dress code. "Put downs" will not be tolerated! Focus on **YOUR POSITIVE** aspects. Be careful about what you "promise" the students. No current Student Council member may be in your video. Please watch this step-by-step explanation of how to submit your video:

Videos will be approved once submitted, if you don't hear from student council advisors, it was approved.
5. Student Council meetings will be held the first Monday of each month at 3:05 p.m. via Zoom (CUSD Connect & Track A students). If you are a Track B student, you will attend meetings in-person. Before campaigning make sure this works for your family.
Our first meeting will be Monday, February 1st.
