

Science Fair Interest?

Attention 4th, 5th, and 6th Grade students interested in Science Fair: Are you interested in Science? Then you may want to participate in this year's Science Fair. Below you will find information about what will be required for the Science Fair. **If you are interested in signing up for Science Fair, you and a parent will need to attend a mandatory informational meeting on Thursday, September 26th, 2019 from 5:30-6:00pm in the MPR.**

- ❖ Science Fair Participants must be in **4th, 5th, or 6th Grade.**
- ❖ **6th Grade students** who have previously attended a science fair informational meeting with their parents **do not** need to attend this year's meeting. Those students need to see Mrs. Puentes by the end of September to share their science fair project idea and get their science packet information.
- ❖ 4th and 6th grade students may receive Block FW points if all of the science fair required work is done and completed on time. Fifth grade projects are an assignment for their class, but they may receive Block FW points if their project advances to the CW Science Fair.
- ❖ Science Fair Participants may choose to work alone, or in a group of 2, equally sharing work duties.
- ❖ Students may need to be given a Science Fair project idea if they have limited or no science fair experience.
- ❖ Parents may supervise, give suggestions for editing, but the work must come from the students and they must complete the project.
- ❖ 4th and 6th grade students will be required to have weekly check-ins (with Mrs. Puentes) with work due at each check in. 5th grade students will also have check-ins, but this will be with their teacher.
- ❖ The Fort Washington Science Fair will take place in January.
- ❖ 10 FW Science Fair projects will go on to the CW Area **Science Fair** that will take place in February.
- ❖ **6th Grade Students who have qualifying projects** from the CW Science Fair will go on to the Fresno County Science Fair in March.
