

## **2024-25 History Day Parent/Student Informational Meeting on 9/26/2024**

Are you a **4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, or 6<sup>th</sup> grade FW student** who is interested in history, research, debate, or public speaking? If so, participating in History Day may be for you. Participants in History Day research historical events and prepare presentations in various formats, including posters, speeches, and websites, all while earning credit towards Block FW and gaining valuable insight into the past. You don't have to be working on Block FW points to participate. Any 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, or 6<sup>th</sup> grade student can participate. History Day meetings will be every Tuesday, beginning the first week in October, with students finishing their projects in January and participating in an area competition at that time. The Fresno County Regional History Day competition will be held in March. Students will be required to participate in both Competitions to receive Block FW points and to be considered a History Day Participant.
