

Bud Rank Student Leadership Information



Summary:

The students at Bud Rank learn the fundamentals of student government through the Leadership Organization, also known as student council. Student body elections will be held soon. Applications must be completed and returned by all students through permission click, who want to run for office.

Bud Rank Leadership takes an active role in sponsoring and planning various student activities and enhancing communication between the students and the staff.

Students wishing to run for an office must be in good standing in behavior and also in academics. Students are to complete an application and secure teacher and parent approval in order to have their names placed on a ballot. Any student who chooses to run for an office, regardless of being elected, will receive one Block BR point. If a student is appointed to an office they will receive two Block BR points. Classroom representatives will receive one point for Block BR and are elected by teacher's discretion.



OFFICE	GRADES	RESPONSIBILITIES
President for each grade level (3 positions)	4 th , 5 th 6 th	Preside over student body assemblies, meetings, and student council. Assists the staff in organizing and running school events and activities. Works with KRAV team. 6 th grade president will also be the president overall.
Vice President	6 th Grade Only	Take the place of the President in his/her absence. Assists the President in Leadership and student activities and events. Keeps attendance of student council members at meetings. Decorate the KRAV backdrop. Work with the KRAV team.
Secretary	5 th Grade Only	Keep accurate notes of all meetings and correspondence. Reports on the previous meeting's agenda. Organize thank-you notes for staff and community. Decorate the KRAV backdrop. Works the KRAV team.
Safety Commissioner	4 th Grade Only	Times fire/safety drills. Assists administration with safety campaigns & checks. Works the KRAV team.

- ✓ Officers who won during the 1st semester cannot run for the same office in the 2nd semester, but may choose a new office.
- ✓ Choose an office that excites you or you are passionate about!
- ✓ Don't worry about running against peers; we are proud you are running and so are your friends!
- ✓ If you hear a lot of students are running for one office, branch out and choose another one!
- ✓ Practice your speech multiple times before filming.
