- 22-23 Bell Schedule with Advisory Period and Thursday AM Intervention- Principal Moua shared this is exciting that teachers get to offer morning interventions to students who may not be able to stay afterschool for academic support. Teachers are all opening their doors to provide small group or 1:1 academic support to students. It is a new thing on campus so the staff and administration will revisit this model at semester end and make tweaks where necessary.
- 21-22 Data & 22-23 SY site wide focus: Academics, MTSS/SEL, & School Pride- Principal Moua shared the three areas of focus for this year and the next couple years. The purpose for identifying these areas is to be intentional about the work that is being done at Kastner for student's academic achievement as well as development of character and put in place systemic approaches to support students with their social-emotional needs.
- EL Reclassification- Currently there are 39 EL students who are still in the EL program and 9 EL students have been reclassified this year. There are still some students on the bubble who will be reclassified after this semester.
- Staffing Updates: Principal Moua shared there is a new GIS at Kastner, Mrs. Vanessa Savoy, but she is out on maternity leave for the time being and Mr. Tate and Valdivia will be stepping in for Savoy.
- Catapult Alert System- Principal Moua shared the powerpoint on school safety and the new CatapultEMS system the district is using moving forward.
- Fentanyl- Principal Moua shared the town hall meeting held at CNEC a couple weeks ago and encouraged parents to speak with their children about this rising issue/concern. Principal Moua also shared emails and

notices have been posted on the school social media page and website alerting parents how dangerous this drug is.
