Application Overview

The RAY JONES SCHOLARSHIP FUND, established in 2009 at Central Valley Community Foundation, provides financial assistance to selected California Indian students graduating from high school in the central valley. At least five scholarship awards each in the amount of \$2,500 may be awarded to selected applicants seeking a postsecondary degree at an accredited two or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school, and at least one \$5,000 scholarship may be awarded to a selected applicant seeking a bachelor's degree at a four-year college or university. This scholarship serves California Indian students graduating from high school in Merced, Mariposa, Madera, Fresno, Kings and Tulare counties. Priority in the selection process is given to California Indian students graduating from Sierra High School located in Tollhouse, Fresno County, in memory of Ray Jones, Class of 1965, and in honor of his Mono-Chukchansi heritage.

Eligible applicants must:

- Be of California Indian descent;
- Be a graduating senior in good standing with a minimum 2.0 G.P.A.;
- Graduate from high school in Merced, Mariposa, Madera, Fresno, Kings or Tulare County;
- Demonstrate financial need; and
- Seek enrollment in a postsecondary degree program at an accredited two or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school.

Eligible applicants must submit the following documents for consideration by the scholarship selection committee:

Proof of California Indian descent (e.g., Tribal ID card or letter from a federally or non-federally recognized California Native American Tribe, Bureau of Indian Affairs documentation, California Rolls documentation, birth certificates showing descent from a documented California Indian)

Copy of SAT and/or ACT scores
Statement of financial need
Essay of 500 words or less:

Personal Statement of 1,000 words or less:
