Dr. Shapiro welcomed all attendees to the meeting.


Diversity Council

CTE Pathway Discussion

Learning Director, Katie Aiello spoke at the meeting regarding CUSD's CTE and AP pathways. CUSD currently has 21 different CTE pathways. These pathways prepare students for future career opportunities, giving them valuable hands-on learning opportunities. CUSD has 3,000 students involved in CTE.

AP Pathway Discussion

Currently there are 22 different AP courses that are offered to students. There are 880 students registered to take AP exams. Clovis North is the highest AP school in the district, with 85% of our students passing their AP exams with a score of 3 or higher.

Seal of Biliteracy Award

Deputy Principal, Jon Bowns shared information regarding changes the state has made to the Seal of Biliteracy Award.

To earn this award a student must first demonstrate proficiency in English, as well as two or more foreign languages.


The recent change made by the state allows a school to administer an exam to a student, allowing the student an opportunity to demonstrate proficiency in a foreign language that is not offered at the school.
