

If you would like to volunteer at CNEC, please follow the steps below:

To use the code, simply open smartphone camera and hover it over the code as if a picture is going to be taken. Phone should automatically read it and open an internet link that goes directly to the form.

- 2. Get TB Assessment (call HR 327-9311).
- 3. Upload TB Assessment at same time as completing online application or return clearance to advisor and they will give to staff to upload (online application must be completed before CNEC staff can upload TB clearance).
- 4. If chaperoning an overnight trip or going to be alone with students, fingerprint clearance is necessary.

TB Risk Assessments and TB skin test results are good for four years.
