  - Graduation

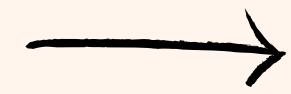
## HIGH SCHOOL IS DIFFERENT

You will need to self-advocate a little more



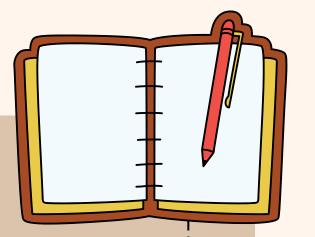
