





Students must pass all classes with a D or higher.

- World Language and Math classes require C or higher to advance to the next level course.
- Students aiming to be 4-year college eligible must pass with C's or higher in all classes.



- Students with low grades in Math 8 may be assigned a Math Tutorial class as their elective.




