# Required 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Classes

All Sophomores must take:

- English
- Math
- Science
- Physical Education (PE)
- Social Science- World History, AP World History, or AP European History.
- *\*To be NCAA compliant, recommend four academic classes per year.*
- Students must pass all classes with a D or higher.



# Clovis West Graduation Requirements

# English

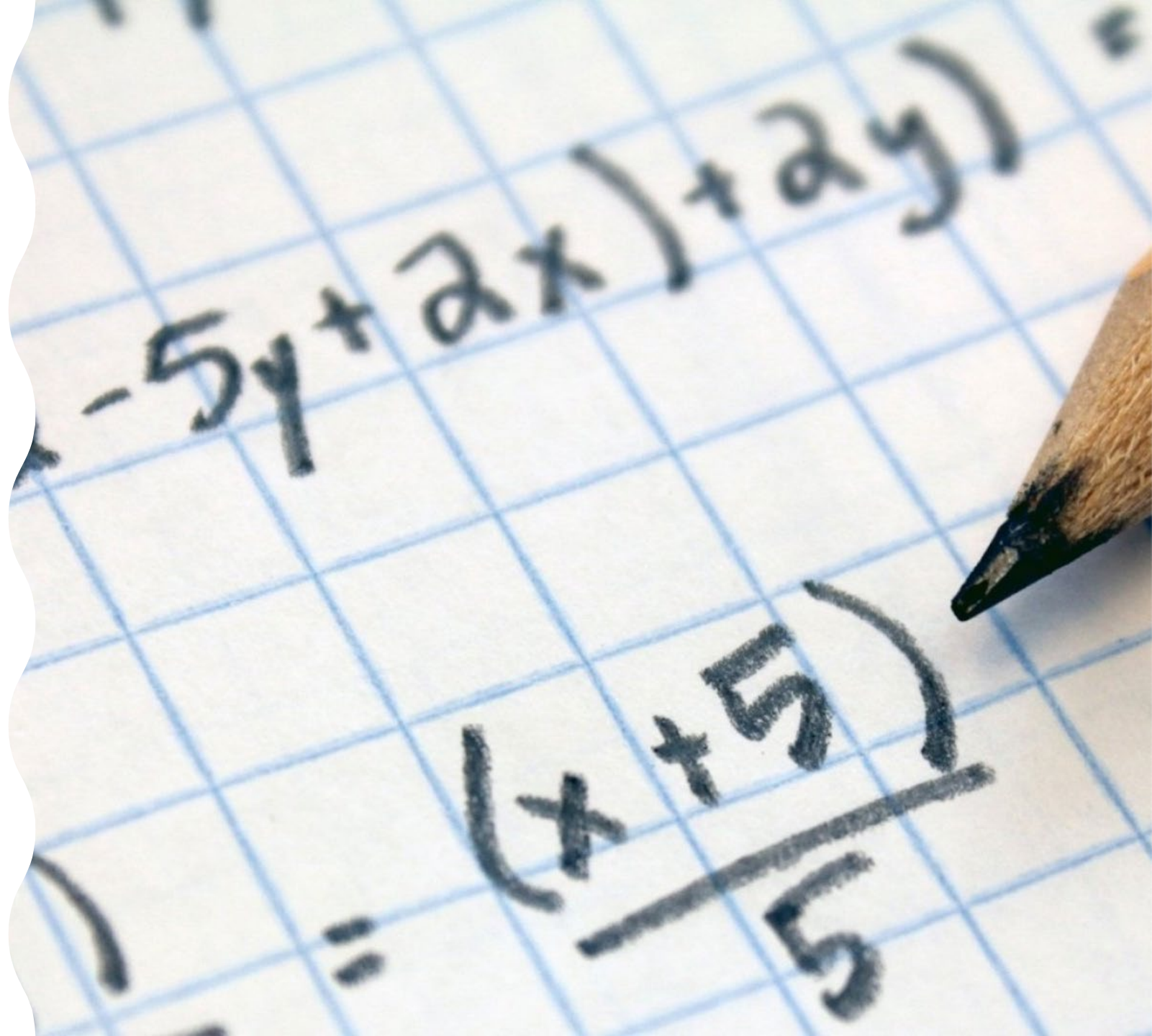
- **English 10**
  - General English course covering reading, writing, research and grammar.
  - Fulfills high school and CSU/UC requirement.
- **AP Seminar**
  - Focused on skills colleges say they need students to be competent in, including research, writing, and presentation skills.
  - Fulfills high school and CSU/UC requirement.
  - College credit
  - Weighted on 5 point scale
- **Explorations in Child and Adolescent Literature (HP)**
  - CTE Education Pathway course
  - English skills learned through the lens of a teacher, looking at how to teach content to students and reading and writings focused on education.

# Math Placement Guidelines

9 <sup>th</sup> Grade Math Class	1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> Semester Grade	10 <sup>th</sup> Grade Placement
Math 1	A, B, C	Math 2
Math 2	A, B, C	Math 3
Honors Math 2	A, B, C	Honors Math 3

**If you received a D or F in one or both semesters, your counselor will work with you on your next math placement and/or summer school options.**

- Honors Spanish 2 P – offered for students who are native speakers.
- Honors Spanish P
- AP Chinese HP
- AP Spanish Language HP
- California State Seal of Biliteracy

**\*2 years of the same World Language is required by the CSU/UC system, 3rd year recommended.**


