- Weighted on 5 point scale


Explorations in Child and Adolescent Literature (HP)





- California State Seal of Biliteracy















What is an Impacted Schedule?

Students enrolled in any of the following courses/programs are considered to have an impaction in their schedule which allows them to take a summer course for original credit.






